The Administrator reviewed the financial reasons why it is best not to formally open the Community Center in 2010 for regular use. General discussion took place about alcohol licensed establishment fees, court costs and other costs.

The Administrator touched on the 2010 budget and the Township Council was in agreement to move forward with the draft budget and the cap levy waiver application before the Department of Community Affairs (DCA).
