As the township continues to make substantial roadway and infrastructure improvements throughout the community, we have determined the sequencing for the 2017 Florence Township Road Program & Hornberger Avenue Phase II paving.

HORNBERGER AVENUE – Phase II

Phase II of Hornberger Avenue work will begin the week following the Patriotic Day parade which is held on July 8th this year. This project is large all by itself and it will not only involve repaving the roadway, but drainage improvements will be installed at Seventh Avenue and curb, sidewalk, and handicap ramps will also be improved.

2017 ROAD PROGRAM

Weather permitting, concrete work on curbs, sidewalks, and handicap apron ramps is set to begin the Week of June 19th. If all goes well and the weather cooperates, the first road surface milling and repaving will follow the concrete work and could begin as early as the week of June 26th.

As with any large project, we know there will be some difficulties with schedules and there will be minor temporary inconveniences. This is especially true when having to coordinate around many sizable community events while also dealing with PSEG and their gas main replacement work. Our contractor is fully aware of our events and activities in the community and will always work to minimize impacts. We ask for your patience and cooperation during the projects.

Below is an anticipated sequence for the road program repaving work that could begin as early as June 26th.

1. Florence Meadows
2. West Third Street from Boulevard to Union Street
3. West Fifth Street from Bodine Street to Richardson Street
4. Pine Street from Wilbur Henry to Shafer Drive & Shaver Drive from Cedar Ln to dead-end
5. Alden Avenue (small parking extension near tracks below the hill at Roland Avenue)
6. West Third Street from Summer Street to Boulevard
7. West Second Street from Union Street to Foundry Street
8. Loop of Winter Street, Riverview Avenue, Summer Street
9. East Sixth Street from Pine Street to Cedar Street & Cedar Street from 5th St. to E. 6th St
10. East Third Street from Walnut Street to Pine Street
