

ELCON Hazardous Waste Processing Plant

Elcon Recycling wants to build a hazardous waste processing plant in Falls Township only half a mile from the Delaware River which provides drinking water to more than 5 million people in three states. Since the river is tidal, those living up stream could be affected just like those living downstream.

Elcon is planning to boil down 596 different types of hazardous materials, including bio-waste and heavy metals, into sludge by using an unproven technology here in the United States. At the present time we are unaware of any receiving facility that exists for handling this toxic sludge after it's been processed.

FACTS:

- 17 to 25 truckloads of hazardous waste brought in daily
- 50 to 55 million gallons of hazardous waste water processed per year
 - ½ mile from Elcon site is the Delaware River
- 10 states will send to Elcon: MA, RI, CT, NY, NJ, PA, DE, MD, VA & NC
- 30 mile distance potential for vapors and particulates from burning hazardous waste
 - 10,000+ school children attend school within 4 miles of the proposed site
 - Only 50 permanent jobs are anticipated for the site.
