ORDINANCE 2012-02

**An Ordinance of the Township Of Florence Amending the
Florence Township Code, Chapter 5 on Committees and to
Establish an Economic
Development Committee**

Whereas, the Township Council has determined that it is appropriate to provide for an Economic Development Committee to provide advice to the Mayor and Township Council with regard to the economic development and marketing of the Township,

Now, Therefore, Be It Ordained by the Township Council of the Township of Florence that:

Section 1. The Code of the Township of Florence is hereby amended Chapter 5 as follows:

CHAPTER 5

ADVISORY COMMITTEES

ARTICLE I

Economic Development Committee

§ 5-1 Economic Development Committee Established.

There is hereby established an Economic Development Committee to consist of six (6) citizen members appointed as provided herein and a member of the Council appointed by the Council. Up to four (4) additional Emeritus Members may be appointed by the Mayor and approved by the Council.

§ 5-2 Appointment of the Economic Development Committee.

The members of the Economic Development Committee shall be appointed to one (1) year terms. All terms shall begin on January 1st and shall end on December 31st. Vacancies

shall be filled by appointment in the same manner as the original appointment for the unexpired term of the member whose vacancy is being filled.

Six (6) of the members shall be appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by Council.

Up to four (4) ex-official members who were active members maybe appointed by the Mayor with consent of Council. Their term ends when they no longer residents of Florence Township. These Members Emeritus have all the rights and privileges of the regular members, except their attendance is not required, they do not count towards quorum and they are not voting members.

§ 5-3 A member of the Council appointed by the Council shall serve as voting member of the Economic Development Committee.

§ 5-4 Administrative Support for the Economic Development Committee

The Economic Development Committee may expend funds only within appropriations approved by the Council and as authorized by the Mayor or the Township Administrator. Administrative support shall be provided through the Township Administrator.

§ 5-5 Duties of the Economic Development Committee

The Economic Development Committee shall have the duty to advise the Mayor and Council with regard to the following:

- a. To conduct research into potential economic development of the Township, in areas appropriate for such development;
- b. Develop and recommend to the Mayor and Council a marketing plan for the Township of Florence;
- c. Within the limits of appropriations and subject to the approval of the Mayor and Council, to advertise, prepare, print and distribute materials to support the economic development of the Township;
- d. To perform such other acts as are reasonably related to and designed to carry out the purposes and objectives of the committee as authorized by the Mayor and Council;
- e. To keep records of the meetings and activities of the committee and to make quarterly reports to the Mayor and Council.

Section 2. If a court of competent jurisdiction shall declare any section, paragraph, subsection, clause or provision of this Ordinance invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of this Ordinance as a whole or any part thereof.

Section 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances of the Township of Florence heretofore adopted that are inconsistent with any of the terms and provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

Section 4. This ordinance shall become effective after proper passage and publication in accordance with the law.
