

**FLORENCE TOWNSHIP
ORDINANCE NO. 2013-20**

**AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE COMPENSATION OF EMPLOYEES OF THE
DEPARTMENT OF POLICE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF FLORENCE
PATROL OFFICERS – DETECTIVES – SERGEANTS
FOR 2014**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Council of the Township of Florence a majority of the members concurring therein as follows:

SECTION 1: The following standard salary ranges and rates are hereby established for members of the Florence Township Police Department who are employed by the Township of Florence as Police Patrol Officers and Detectives:

The following ranges of salary are hereby established for all employees employed after January 1, 2014:

SECTION 2: The following standard salary ranges and rates are hereby established for members of the Florence Township Police Department who are employed by the Township of Florence as Police Sergeants:

SECTION 3: The salaries provided herein shall be for contract year 2014. The salary schedule and any adjustments within the maximum salary percentages shall be done in accordance with the terms of the contracts that were ratified by the Township Council at a public meeting on November 6, 2013.

SECTION 4: The starting salary for any new patrol officer of the Department of Police shall be the lowest rate in the office, position or job title. Applicants with outstanding qualifications or experience may be hired above the lowest rate with the approval of the Township Council.

SECTION 5: The pay period for employees listed under “Payable Weekly” shall be for the period beginning on Thursday and ending the following Wednesday of each and every week.

SECTION 6: REPEALER. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances heretofore adopted which are inconsistent with the terms and provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

SECTION 7: VALIDITY. If any section, sentence, clause, provision, or portion of this Ordinance shall be held to be invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, such holdings shall not effect or impair any other section, sentences, clauses, provisions or portions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 8: EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance shall not take effect until final publication and passage by the Township Council of the Township of Florence provided however that the rates of employment contained in this Ordinance shall be effective on January 1, 2014.
