

**TOWNSHIP OF FLORENCE**

**ORDINANCE 2015-33**

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE ACQUISITION  
OF REAL PROPERTY KNOWN AS BLOCK 8, LOT 2 AND BLOCK 9, LOTS 1  
AND 2 IN THE TOWNSHIP OF FLORENCE FOR REMEDIATION  
OF BLIGHT AND POSSIBLE FUTURE ROADWAY IMPROVEMENTS**

**WHEREAS**, there is within the Township of Florence (“Township”), certain real property known as Block 8, Lot 2 and Block 9, Lots 1 and 2 on the official tax map of the Township (217 Foundry Street) (hereinafter “the Property”), and more particularly described on a legal description as provided by Maser Consulting prepared for and on behalf of the Township, attached hereto as Exhibit A, which the Township believes is appropriate for acquisition for remediation of blight and possible future roadway improvements; and

**WHEREAS**, the Township has ensured that the appropriate inspections have been conducted on the Property in order to determine its current condition;

**WHEREAS**, the Township and the record owners of the properties concluded a bona fide negotiation process, whereby the Township will acquire the property by way of mutual agreement and has agreed to pay the record owner of Block 8, Lot 2 and Block 9, Lots 1 and 2 the sum of \$2,500.00 in order to acquire the property; and

**WHEREAS**, the Township is acquiring the property consistent with its authority to acquire privately-owned land for public purposes, pursuant to the Local Land and Buildings Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:12-1 et seq., and wishes to memorialize its authority to acquire the property consistent with law and pursuant to this Ordinance; and

**WHEREAS**, sufficient funds have been appropriated by the Township in order to acquire the subject property;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Township Council of the Township of Florence in the County of Burlington, State of New Jersey that:

1. The Township of Florence does hereby purchase and acquires the property, and
2. The Township Solicitor, on behalf of the governing body, along with Township staff, is authorized to take all steps necessary and legally required to conclude and close the purchase of the property, with a purchase price not to exceed \$2,500.00, and subject to the conditions set forth in this Ordinance above.
