ORDINANCE 2016-23

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 1988-26, PASSED ON DECEMBER 7, 1988 AND REVISING CHAPTER 4, ARTICLE VII OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF FLORENCE, ENTITLED "ORGANIZATION AND ADMINISTRATION"

WHEREAS, the Township Council of the Township of Florence annually adopts a resolution establishing the salaries for administrative personnel, which is posted on the municipal website and accessible to any individual pursuant to the submission of an appropriate request to the Township Clerk; and

WHEREAS, the Township Council recognizes the benefits of the advancements in technology and the ability to disseminate public information in a manner that previously was unavailable; and

WHEREAS, the Township Council has determined that it is no longer necessary to publish the annual salary resolution in a newspaper circulating with the Township at least ten days prior to introduction and adoption and wishes to amend the section of the Township Code that requires this publication;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Council of the Township of Florence in the County of Burlington, State of New Jersey that Chapter 4 of the Township Code be and is hereby amended as follows:

ARTICLE I: AMENDED SECTIONS. Chapter 4 of this Code, entitled "Organization and Administration" is supplemented as follows"

1. §4-27 through §4-29(a) remain unchanged.
2. §4-29(b) is hereby amended and shall read as follows:

"A salary resolution shall be adopted by the Council establishing the annual salary for administrative personnel."

ARTICLE II. Repealer, Severability and Effective Date.

1. Repealer. Any and all Ordinances inconsistent with the terms of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of any such inconsistencies.
2. Severability. In the event that any clause, section, paragraph or sentence of this Ordinance is deemed to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, then the Township Council hereby declares its intent that the balance of the Ordinance not affected by said invalidity shall remain in full force and effect to the extent that it allows the Township to meet the goals of the Ordinance.
3. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take effect upon proper passage in accordance with the law.
