

PSE&G Electric Distribution Tower Upgrades

Recently, PSE&G notified the township about a long-term project that will begin in 2018 and end in 2022. The project involves replacement of the 14 existing lattice towers that cross the rural portion of the township. As part of the utility's Resilience and Reliability project, the 70+ year old lattice towers will be replaced since they are not capable of supporting a new high voltage power cable system being run across the state. The proposed new towers under this project are going to be a single pole design and will be somewhat taller so they can carry a higher voltage line from Metuchen to Burlington.
