The Fountain Foundation and the Township of Florence are pleased to announce the restoration of 220 Foundry Street. This building was beautifully converted to 6 affordable apartment units by the Fountain Foundation.

On June 18, 2015 Mrs. Alicemae Agostinelli accompanied by her family and son-in-law, Dennis O'Hara cut the ribbon to officially mark the rebirth of this classically styled building that was once the beloved home of the Green Star Inn and the Agostinelli family. This project saved a building that is historically significant in the township and it will again be occupied by families in the community.

The Agostinelli Family owned and operated the Green Star Inn for decades and it was a place where life stories were told and memories were made many times over. Workers from the R.D. Wood Pipe Foundry and the Griffin Pipe Foundry, as well as friends and family members would frequently enjoy the hospitality and friendly atmosphere of the Green Star Inn.

As Mrs. Agostinelli's daughter, Christina, said as part of the dedication, 220 Foundry Street reminded her of how much people cared for their family and neighbors, and that the restoration symbolizes "a place where new dreams are achieved and a sense of community will thrive."
