ORDINANCE NO. 2012-14

An Ordinance of the Township of Florence Amending Chapter 140, Article VI of the Code of the Township of Florence Establishing Fees and Charges for the Disposal of Septic and Grey Water

WHEREAS, septic and grey water disposal is generated from septic systems and grey water separating systems, and;

WHEREAS, the Township Council has determined that septic and grey water haulers may dispose of the materials at the Florence Township Wastewater Treatment Facility, and;

WHEREAS, the Township Council has consulted with the Water and Sewer Director in order to establish parameters and fees for the disposal of septic and grey water.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Council of the Township of Florence that:

Section 1. Chapter 140 (Water and Sewer), Article VI (Rate Schedule) of the Code of the Township of Florence is hereby amended to add section 140-48.1 entitled: Fees and Charges for Private Septic and Grey Water Haulers.

Section 2. Chapter 140-48.1.A is added to read as follows: Licensed Private Septic and Grey Water haulers approved by the Township of Florence are authorized to utilize the Florence Township Wastewater Treatment Plant to dispose of the materials they collect. The Water and Sewer Director is authorized to promulgate rules and procedures that must be followed in order to dispose of septic and grey water at the wastewater treatment plant. Private haulers are permitted to only bring residential and light commercial septic and grey water to the facility if it is not laden with heavy grease.

Section 3. Chapter 140-48.1.B is added to read as follows: The fee for the disposal of septic and grey water disposal at the Florence Township Treatment Plant is \$0.0375 per gallon.

Section 4. If any section, paragraph, subsection, clause, or provision of this Ordinance shall be declared invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of this Ordinance as a whole or any part thereof.

Section 5. All ordinances or parts of ordinances of the Township of Florence heretofore adopted that are inconsistent with any of the terms and provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

Section 6. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon adoption and publication of notice of adoption as provided by law.
