ORDINANCE 2018-26

An Ordinance of the Township of Florence Amending Chapter 134, Schedule XIX of the Florence Township Code to Amend the Speed Limit on Railroad Avenue between Delaware Avenue and Cedar Lane

Whereas, the Chief of Police has performed a speed study of Railroad Avenue to determine the average speed of travel for Railroad Avenue between Delaware Avenue and Cedar Lane, and

Whereas, the Chief of Police and the Assistant Township Administrator have reviewed the data and found it sufficient to recommend a speed reduction for the roadway from 40 miles per hour to 35 miles per hour,

Now, Therefore, Be It Ordained by the Township Council of the Township of Florence that:

Section 1. The Code of the Township of Florence is hereby amended by revising Chapter 134, Section 51, Schedule XIX: Speed Limits; to reduce the speed for Railroad Avenue between Delaware Avenue and Cedar Lane, from 40 mph to 35 mph.

Section 2. If any section, paragraph, subsection, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be declared invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of this Ordinance as a whole or any part thereof.

Section 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances of the Township of Florence heretofore adopted that are inconsistent with any of the terms and provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage. Notice of adoption shall be published as provided by law.
