

An Ordinance of the Township of Florence Amending Chapter 134 of the Florence Township Code to Establish a Stop Intersection at Fourth Street and Woodlawn Avenue

Whereas, the Assistant Township Administrator and the Acting Chief of Police of the Township of Florence have recommended that the intersection of Fourth Street at Woodlawn Avenue should be designated as a stop intersection and

Whereas, the Township Council has considered the recommendation of the Assistant Township Administrator and the Acting Chief of Police and determines that it is necessary to designate the intersection of Fourth Street at Woodlawn Avenue as a stop intersection in accordance with Chapter 134 of the Florence Township Code,

Now, Therefore, Be It Ordained by the Township Council of the Township of Florence that:

Section 1. The Code of the Township of Florence is hereby amended by revising Chapter 134, Section 43, Schedule XI Stop Intersections to add the following provisions:


Stop Sign On	At Intersection Of
Fourth Street - South side of Woodlawn Avenue	Woodlawn Avenue

Section 2. If any section, paragraph, subsection, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be declared invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of this Ordinance as a whole or any part thereof.

Section 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances of the Township of Florence heretofore adopted that are inconsistent with any of the terms and provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage. Notice of adoption shall be published as provided by law.
