**AUTHORIZING PARTICIPATION IN THE BURLINGTON COUNTY
SAFE STREETS INITIATIVE AND EXECUTING THE
COOPERATION AGREEMENT FOR MUTUAL LAW ENFORCEMENT AID**

WHEREAS, Burlington County has created the Burlington County Law Enforcement Safe Streets Initiative pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:14-156 and 40A:14-156.1 et seq.; and

WHEREAS, the Burlington County Safe Streets Initiative was formed to provide a coordinated law enforcement approach to fight crime, protect life and property, enforce the law and maintain the peace; and

WHEREAS, participation in the Burlington County Safe Street Initiative includes the opportunity to receive funding from the County Law Enforcement Trust Account (C.L.E.T.A); and

WHEREAS, Florence Township Chief of Police, John Bunce, has indicated that participation in this initiative would be beneficial to the Florence Township Police Department as well as to the citizens of Florence Township.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the Township of Florence, County of Burlington, State of New Jersey that Florence Township is hereby authorized to participate in the Burlington County Safe Streets Initiative; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor and the Chief of Police of the Township of Florence are hereby authorized and directed to execute the Burlington County Safe Streets Initiative Cooperation Agreement for Mutual Law Enforcement Aid.
