

RESOLUTION NO. 2019-129
SOIL MOVEMENT PERMIT REQUEST
57 FOUNTAIN BOULEVARD, BLOCK 171.03, LOT 13

WHEREAS, Kyle J. Spohn, E.I.T, from the engineering firm of William H. Nicholson Associates, P.A. on behalf of the property owner of 57 Fountain Boulevard, has contacted Florence Township concerning the need to import soil to 57 Fountain Boulevard, Block 171.03, Lot 13; and

WHEREAS, the imported soil will be used to improve the grading on the lot in support of the construction of a new house; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Spohn estimates that the amount of imported soil will not exceed 2,000 cubic yards; and

WHEREAS, the Township Engineer has reviewed the proposal and will oversee the soil importation; and

WHEREAS, Florence Township has determined that the request is reasonable and in order.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Township of Florence, County of Burlington, State of New Jersey, that the importation of no more than 2,000 cubic yards of soil to 57 Fountain Boulevard is hereby authorized. The applicable fee of \$100.00 will be paid, and bonding requirements are waived in favor of utilizing the proper grading and stabilization of the imported soil as a condition of the residential Certificate of Occupancy to ensure completion of the project as required by the Township Engineer.
