

**RESOLUTION NO. 2019-175
 AUTHORIZE PURCHASE OF TWO CHEVROLET TAHOES
 FOR THE POLICE DEPARTMENT
 COOPERATIVE PRICING SYSTEM PURCHASE**

WHEREAS, the Township Council of the Township of Florence has authorized the purchase of two (2) police rated vehicles and accessory equipment through the Cranford Cooperative Pricing System of which the Township of Florence is a member and through the New Jersey State Contract Program; and

WHEREAS, the purchase of goods and services by local contracting units is authorized by the Local Public Contracts Law, NJS 40A:11-11 (5); and

WHEREAS, the Township is purchasing two (2) 2019 Chevrolet Tahoes from Day Chevrolet, 1600 Golden Mile Highway, Monroeville, PA 15146 under the Cranford Cooperative Pricing System Contract ID # 47-CPCPS; and

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police and Township Administrator recommend the utilization of this public contract on the grounds that it represents the best price and service available; and


WHEREAS, the vehicles are being ordered now due to a need to maintain the police fleet; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Finance Officer has certified that funds are available for the vehicle purchase.


