

**RESOLUTION NO. 2019-45
AUTHORIZE PURCHASE OF A CHEVROLET TAHOE
AND FORD UTILITY INTERCEPTOR,
COOPERATIVE PRICING SYSTEM PURCHASE**

WHEREAS, the Township Council of the Township of Florence has authorized the purchase of two (2) police rated vehicles and accessory equipment through the Cranford Cooperative Pricing System of which the Township of Florence is a member and through the New Jersey State Contract Program; and

WHEREAS, the purchase of goods and services by local contracting units is authorized by the Local Public Contracts Law, NJS 40A:11-11 (5); and

WHEREAS, the Township is purchasing a 2019 Chevrolet Tahoe from Day Chevrolet, 1600 Golden Mile Highway, Monroeville, PA 15146 under the Cranford Cooperative Pricing System Contract ID #47-CPCPS and a 2020 Ford Utility Interceptor under NJ Contract # 88728 from Cherry Hill Winner Ford, 250 Haddonfield-Berlin Road, Cherry Hill, NJ 08034; and

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police and Township Administrator recommend the utilization of this contract on the grounds that it represents the best price and service available; and

WHEREAS, the vehicles are being ordered now due to a need to maintain the police fleet; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Finance Officer has certified that funds are available for the vehicle purchase.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Township of Florence, County of Burlington, State of New Jersey, that Day Chevrolet be awarded a contract for one (1) Chevrolet Tahoe and Cherry Hill Winner Ford be awarded a contract for one (1) Ford Utility Interceptor, and accessory equipment.
