Resolution 2019-61

A Resolution of the Township Council of the Township of Florence Setting the Hours for Sale of Alcoholic Beverages for Consumption On-premises for St. Patrick's Day, Sunday, March 17, 2019

Whereas, the Township of Florence has adopted Ordinance 2005-03 which allows the Township Council, in its exclusive discretion, to adopt a Resolution extending the hours for holders of plenary retail consumption and club licenses to engage in sales of alcoholic beverages for consumption on the licensed premises, on Sunday beyond 12:00 midnight for not more than two (2) hours on dates where the Township Council, in its exclusive discretion, determines that there are special events, such as, but not limited to, major national sporting events, that warrant the extended hours, and


Whereas, the Township Council has determined that a special event, St. Patrick's Day, will occur on Sunday, March 17, 2019, and that it is appropriate for the Township Council to exercise its exclusive discretion to extend the hours for the sale of alcoholic beverages for consumption on the licensed premises, for holders of plenary retail consumption and club licenses, by two (2) hours.

Now, Therefore Be It Resolved by the Township Council of the Township of Florence, assembled in public session on March 13, 2019, that:

1. The Township Council finds and determines that St. Patrick's Day, Sunday, March 17, 2019, is a special event of substantial interest to the citizens of the Township of Florence and is the type of event for which the Township Council may exercise its exclusive discretion to extend the hours for the sale of alcoholic beverages for consumption on the licensed premises, for holders of plenary retail consumption and club licenses, by two (2) hours.
2. Accordingly, the hours for the sale of alcoholic beverages for consumption on the licensed premises, for holders of plenary retail consumption and club licenses, is extended on St. Patrick's Day, Sunday, March 17, 2019, by two (2) hours, i.e. to 2:00 a.m. on Monday, March 18, 2019.

Be It Further Resolved, that the Township Clerk shall send copies of this Resolution to all holders of plenary retail consumption licenses and club licenses and to the Chief of Police of the Township of Florence for their information and attention.

The foregoing resolution was duly adopted by the Township Council of the Township of Florence at a public meeting held on March 13, 2019.
