

FLORENCE TOWNSHIP ORDINANCE 2026-13

CAPITAL ORDINANCE STATEMENTS AND SUMMARY

PUBLIC NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the ordinance, the summary terms of which are included herein, has been finally adopted by the Township Council of the Township of Florence, in the County of Burlington, New Jersey on June 17, 2026, and the twenty (20) day period of limitation within which a suit, action or proceeding questioning the validity of such ordinance can be commenced, as provided in the Local Bond Law, has begun to run from the date of the first publication of this statement. Copies of the full ordinance are available at no cost and during regular business hours, at the Township Clerk's office in Municipal Building to the members of the general public who shall request the same. The summary of the terms of such ordinance follows:

Title: AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF FLORENCE, IN THE COUNTY OF BURLINGTON, NEW JERSEY, PROVIDING FOR THE ACQUISITION OF TWO POLICE PURSUIT RATED SUV'S WITH UPFIT AND REQUIRED EMERGENCY SERVICES EQUIPMENT FOR POLICE DEPARTMENT OPERATIONS AND APPROPRIATING \$170,000 TO FUND THE SAME.

Purpose(s): The acquisition of two police pursuit rated suv's with upfit and required emergency services equipment for police department operations

Appropriation: \$170,000 (General Capital Fund Balance)
