ORDINANCE 2026-15

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 91, ARTICLE XL CONDITIONAL USES OF
THE TOWNSHIP CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF FLORENCE TO ALLOW FOR EARLY
CONSUMPTION AND SALE OF CANNABIS AT LOCATIONS SPECIFICALLY
APPROVED FOR CLASS 5 RETAIL SALES AND WITH CLASS 5 RETAIL SALES
ESTABLISHMENTS CONTAINING CONSUMPTION AREAS

Take Notice that the Ordinance identified above amends Chapter 91, Article XL Conditional Uses of the Township Code to allow for early consumption and sale of cannabis at locations specifically approved for Class 5 Retail Sales and with Class 5 Retail Sales establishments containing consumption areas.

The Ordinance has been adopted on first reading by the Township Council of the Township of Florence, County of Burlington, State of New Jersey, held on June 17, 2026. It will be considered for final passage after public hearing to be held on July 1, 2026, at 7:00 P.M. in the Municipal Complex, Council Chambers, 711 Broad Street, Florence, New Jersey.
