Sunday, January 25, 2026 (Between 8am-9am) – Anticipated Arrival of Storm

Plowing and Storm Clean Up Efforts

Personnel from Florence Township Public Works and Water & Sewer Departments coordinate with police and fire command to execute all storm related efforts within the township. Some roadways are managed by Burlington County and all plowing, salting and clearing of areas are coordinated. Due to unknown variables of accumulation of snow/ice/rain, we are preparing for an extensive management operation to take place over a duration of several days if necessary. We ask residents and business owners to exercise caution when traveling local roadways and be mindful of all safety precautions provided through the available resources from the attached links. Some items of caution are as follows:

- **Avoid and Report** – ALL down wires, trees, branches or utility poles to Burlington County Central Dispatch. DO NOT approach or attempt to clear hazards.

- **Prepare for Winter Power Outages** – Review the following website for more information, <https://www.ready.gov/winter-weather>
- **Keep Fire Hydrants Clear of Snow**: If possible, safely identify or assist in clearing snow from fire hydrants to remain visible. Please do not attempt to clear heavy snow if you are advised to avoid strenuous activity. Marking the area or communicating with emergency management/plowing personnel is greatly appreciated.
- **When Clearing Driveways or Sidewalks** – Do not shovel or plow snow onto streets. Please support snow clearing efforts by directing excess snow from properties to areas away from the street. Neighbor to neighbor, working together to clear sidewalks and walkways creates safe walking paths within neighborhoods. Please exercise caution as shoveling heavy snow may be detrimental to those over a certain age or with existing health conditions.

Recycling and Trash Collection

The Florence Township Recycling Center will be OPEN on Saturday, January 24th from 9am to 3pm. The center will be closed on Monday, January 26th. Please monitor website and social media updates for hours of operation for the remainder of the week.

Trash Collection Schedule

- ALL trash collection routes scheduled for Monday, January 26th will be shifted to Thursday, January 29th.
- ALL trash collection that takes place in Alleys within the community on Tuesday, January 27th – PLEASE PLACE ALL TRASH ON THE STREET SIDE OF YOUR PROPERTY. Depending on the conditions in the alleys, trash collection may need to be collected on the streetside for additional days during the week.
