
**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF FLORENCE, IN THE COUNTY OF BURLINGTON, NEW JERSEY, PROVIDING FOR ENGINEERING AND IMPLEMENTATION OF EROSION CONTROL AND SOIL STABILIZATION MEASURES ON TOWNSHIP OWNS PROPERTY AND APPROPRIATING \$400,000 TO FUND THE SAME.**


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF FLORENCE, IN THE COUNTY OF BURLINGTON, NEW JERSEY (not less than two-thirds of all members thereof affirmatively concurring) AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. For the purpose of design and implementation of erosion mitigation and Soil stabilization and control measures to Township Owned Property at Block 98.06 Lot 61 located in the vicinity of the Delaware River and homes on Riverbank Drive, there is hereby appropriated the sum of \$400,000 from the Township's General Capital Fund Balance.

Section 2. The capital budget or temporary capital budget (as applicable) of the Township is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency herewith. In the event of any such inconsistency and amendment, the resolution in the form promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing full detail of the amended capital budget or amended temporary capital budget (as applicable) and capital program as approved by the Director of the Division of Local Government Services is on file with the Clerk and is available there for public inspection.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect as provided by law.

CAPITAL ORDINANCE STATEMENTS AND SUMMARY

PUBLIC NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the ordinance, the summary terms of which are included herein, has been finally adopted by the Township Council of the Township of Florence, in the County of Burlington, New Jersey on April 15, 2026, and the twenty (20) day period of limitation within which a suit, action or proceeding questioning the validity of such bond ordinance can be commenced, as provided in the Local Bond Law, has begun to run from the date of the first publication of this statement.
