

ORDINANCE NO. 2026-13

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF FLORENCE, IN THE COUNTY OF BURLINGTON, NEW JERSEY, PROVIDING FOR THE ACQUISITION OF TWO POLICE PURSUIT RATED SUV'S WITH UPFIT AND REQUIRED EMERGENCY SERVICES EQUIPMENT FOR POLICE DEPARTMENT OPERATIONS AND APPROPRIATING \$170,000 TO FUND THE SAME.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF FLORENCE, IN THE COUNTY OF BURLINGTON, NEW JERSEY (not less than two-thirds of all members thereof affirmatively concurring) AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. For the acquisition of two police pursuit rated SUV's with upfit and required emergency services equipment for police department operations, together with and including customization and related equipment to allow the vehicles to be used for their intended use, there is hereby appropriated the sum of \$170,000 from the Township's General Capital Fund Balance.

Section 2. The capital budget or temporary capital budget (as applicable) of the Township is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency herewith. In the event of any such inconsistency and amendment, the resolution in the form promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing full detail of the amended capital budget or amended temporary capital budget (as applicable) and capital program as approved by the Director of the Division of Local Government Services is on file with the Clerk and is available there for public inspection.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect as provided by law.
