ORDINANCE AND SUMMARY

PUBLIC NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the capital ordinance, the summary terms of which are included herein, was duly introduced and passed upon first reading at a regular meeting of the Township Council of the Township of Florence, in the County of Burlington, New Jersey, held on June 3, 2026. It will be further considered for final passage and adoption, after public hearing thereon, at a regular meeting of said Township Council to be held in the Municipal Building, 711 Broad Street, Florence, New Jersey on June 17, 2026 starting at 7 o'clock p.m. During the week prior to and up to and including the date of such meeting, copies of the full ordinance will be made available at no cost and during regular business hours, at the Township Clerk's office in the Township Municipal Building to the members of the general public who shall request the same. The summary of the terms of such ordinance follows:

Title:

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF FLORENCE, IN THE COUNTY OF BURLINGTON, NEW JERSEY, PROVIDING FOR THE ACQUISITION OF TWO POLICE PURSUIT RATED SUV'S WITH UPFIT AND REQUIRED EMERGENCY SERVICES EQUIPMENT FOR POLICE DEPARTMENT OPERATIONS AND APPROPRIATING \$170,000 TO FUND THE SAME.

Purpose(s): The acquisition of two police pursuit rated suv's with upfit and required emergency services equipment for police department operations

Appropriation: \$170,000 (General Capital Fund Balance)
