ORDINANCE 2026-14

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 36, SECTION 4 (HOURS OF SALE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES) OF THE TOWNSHIP CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF FLORENCE TO ALLOW FOR EARLY SALE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES AT LOCATIONS HOLDING A PLENARY RETAIL DISTRIBUTION LICENSE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Council of the Township of Florence in the County of Burlington, State of New Jersey as follows:

ARTICLE I: AMENDED SECTIONS. Section 36-4.A.(2)(b) of Chapter 36, Alcoholic Beverages, is hereby Amended to read as follows with the prior language deleted in its entirety:

Revised Language: Sunday from 9:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m.

ARTICLE II. Repealer, Severability and Effective Date.

1. Repealer. Any and all other Ordinances inconsistent with the terms of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of any such inconsistencies.
2. Severability. In the event that any clause, section, paragraph or sentence of this Ordinance is deemed to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, then the Township Council hereby declares its intent that the balance of the Ordinance not affected by said invalidity shall remain in full force and effect to the extent that it allows the Township to meet the goals of the Ordinance.
3. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take effect upon proper passage in accordance with the law.
