TOWNSHIP OF FLORENCE
ORDINANCE 2026-15

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 91, ARTICLE XL CONDITIONAL USES OF THE TOWNSHIP CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF FLORENCE TO ALLOW FOR EARLY CONSUMPTION AND SALE OF CANNABIS AT LOCATIONS SPECIFICALLY APPROVED FOR CLASS 5 RETAIL SALES AND WITH CLASS 5 RETAIL SALES ESTABLISHMENTS CONTAINING CONSUMPTION AREAS

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Council of the Township of Florence in the County of Burlington, State of New Jersey as follows:

ARTICLE I: AMENDED SECTION. Section 91-293.2.A.(3)(e) of Chapter 91, Article XL Conditional Uses, is hereby Amended to read as follows with the prior language deleted in its entirety:

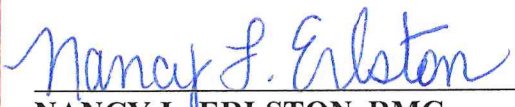
Revised Language: Indoor cannabis consumption shall be limited to the hours between 9:00 a.m. and 10:00 p.m.

ARTICLE II: AMENDED SECTION. Section 91-293.2.B.(3) of Chapter 91, Article XL Conditional Uses, is hereby Amended to read as follows with the prior language deleted in its entirety:

Revised Language: Cannabis establishment licenses Classes 1, 2, 3, 4, and 6 may operate 24 hours per day; however, the hours of operation of Class 5 retail sales shall be limited to 9:00 a.m. and 10:00 p.m.

ARTICLE III. Repealer, Severability and Effective Date.

1. Repealer. Any and all other Ordinances inconsistent with the terms of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of any such inconsistencies.
2. Severability. In the event that any clause, section, paragraph or sentence of this Ordinance is deemed to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, then the Township Council hereby declares its intent that the balance of the Ordinance not affected by said invalidity shall remain in full force and effect to the extent that it allows the Township to meet the goals of the Ordinance.
3. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take effect upon proper passage in accordance with the law.
