

RESOLUTION 2026-142
RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR THE INSERTION OF A SPECIAL ITEM
OF REVENUE IN THE BUDGET OF THE TOWNSHIP OF FLORENCE,
COUNTY OF BURLINGTON, PURSUANT TO N.J.S. 40A:4-87
CHAPTER 159, P.L. 1948

WHEREAS, N.J.S. 40A:4-87 provides that the Director of the Division of Local Government Services may approve the insertion of any special item of revenue in the budget of any county or municipality when such item shall have been made available by law and the amount was not determined at the time of the adoption of the budget; and

WHEREAS, the Director may also approve the insertion of an item of appropriation for equal amount; and

WHEREAS, The Township of Florence has received funding in the amount of \$1,307.02 from the National Opioids Settlement Fund Trust to resolve claims involving their roles in the Country's Opioid Crisis.

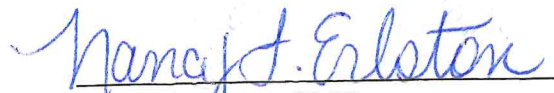
NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Township Council of the Township of Florence in the County of Burlington, New Jersey, hereby requests the Director of the Division of Local Government Services to approve the insertion of an item of revenue in the budget of the year 2026 in the sum of \$1,307.02, which item is now available as revenue from:

National Opioid Settlement in the amount of \$1,307.02.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a like sum of \$1,307.02 is hereby appropriated under the caption National Opioid Settlement; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the above is the result of funds from the National Opioids Settlement Fund Trust in the amount of \$1,307.02.
