RESOLUTION 2026-174
A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING SENATE BILL 4489

WHEREAS, Senate Bill S4489 is an Act concerning speed limits in historic districts and amending R.S. 39:4-98; and

WHEREAS, R.S. 39:4-98 establishes rates of speed for various locations in the State; and

WHEREAS, A “historic district” is defined as an area in the State listed as a historic district in the National Register of Historic Places, pursuant to federal law and the New Jersey Register of Historic Places pursuant to State law.; and

WHEREAS, there is no specific speed limit for historic districts in the state; and

WHEREAS, the Historic Village of Roebling is located in the Township of Florence and is considered a Historic District; and

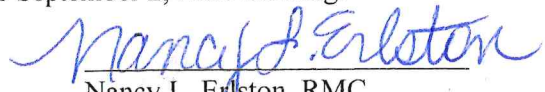
WHEREAS, Senate Bill S-4489 permits municipalities to establish a speed limit of 15 miles per hour in a historic district without performing an engineering and traffic study; and

WHEREAS, the Township Council would like the ability to reduce the maximum permitted speed down to 15 miles per hour in the Village of Roebling.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the Township of Florence that:

1. The Senate is urged to adopt S-4489 and;
2. A copy of this resolution shall be sent to all area legislators as well as the Governor.
