2026 INTERMUNICIPAL SLUDGE MANAGEMENT AGREEMENT**


WHEREAS, the current agreement between Florence Township and Burlington County Board of Commissioners for the disposal of biosolids at the Burlington County Co-Composting Facility expires on December 31, 2025; and

WHEREAS, Burlington County Board of Commissioners adopted Resolution No. 2025-00840 (see Schedule A) authorizing a new agreement for a five-year term commencing January 1, 2026.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Township of Florence that the Township of Florence hereby approves the Agreement with the Board of Commissioners of the County of Burlington regarding the 2026 Intermunicipal Sludge Management Agreement.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor and Township Clerk are authorized to execute any and all documents as required for this Agreement.

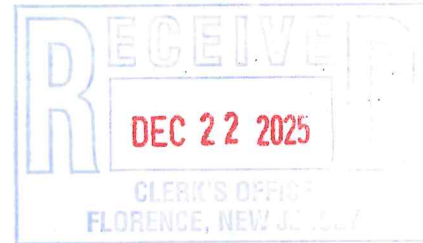

RE: 2026 Intermunicipal Sludge Management Agreement

Dear Mayor Marter:

Enclosed herewith please find three (3) copies of the intermunicipal sludge management agreement between Florence Township and the County of Burlington.

Please note the following changes from the 2021 agreement:

1. All references to an Alternate Facility for the processing of acceptable sludge have been stricken from the agreement. The County cannot guarantee capacity for the Generator's sludge at an alternate facility if it cannot be received at the Co-composting Facility or disposed of at the Landfill.
2. Section 4.1 – Fees for Service - The tipping fee for the first billing year has been increased to \$99.50 per wet ton.
3. Section 4.2 – Billing of the Service Fee - The date by which the County will render a billing statement to the Generator has been changed. The Billing Period to the 1st day of the following Billing Period.
4. Section 6.1 – Term of Agreement - The term of the agreement will coincide with the term of the agreement with the Composting Facility.

All other terms and conditions of the agreement remain the same.

WHEREAS, in accordance with Burlington County's District Solid Waste Management Plan (the "Plan") the Burlington County Board of Chosen Freeholders constructed a Co-Composting Facility (the "Facility") to provide a long-term, reliable and environmentally sound means of sludge disposal; and

WHEREAS, the Burlington County Board of County Commissioners' (the "Board") current contracts with sludge generators, by which they agree to direct dewatered sludge to the Facility, expire on December 31, 2025, and the Board wishes to enter into new contracts with sludge generators for a term commencing January 1, 2026, and expiring on April 1, 2030; now, therefore, the Board

RESOLVED that agreements approved by the County Administrator and County Solicitor with public entities that are capable of complying with the terms and conditions for the Facility's acceptance of dewatered sludge and the other terms and conditions of the County's agreements are hereby authorized subject to approval as to form and content by the County Solicitor, which agreements shall be executed in accordance with the Rules of the Board.
