APPOINTING TEMPORARY SUBSTITUTES FOR MUNICIPAL PROSECUTORS

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 2B:25-4(e) requires a municipality to appoint additional municipal prosecutors, as necessary, to administer justice in a timely and effective manner in its municipal court; and

WHEREAS, *Andrew Smith, Esq.*, was appointed Municipal Prosecutor on January 3, 2024 for a one year term, expiring 12/31/2024; and


WHEREAS, the Municipal Prosecutor may from time to time be unavailable to serve as Municipal Prosecutor at certain court sessions; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 2B:25-4(e) requires the Township Council to appoint temporary substitutes for the Municipal Prosecutor for those occasions when the Municipal Prosecutor is unavailable.

WHEREAS, Township Council appoints Cheryl Cohen and Daniel Gee as temporary substitutes for Municipal Prosecutors; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Township of Florence, County of Burlington, State of New Jersey, that Cheryl Cohen and Daniel Gee, be and are hereby appointed as temporary substitutes for the Municipal Prosecutor, on an as needed basis.
