## TOWNSHIP OF FLORENCE ORDINANCE 2021-22

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF FLORENCE AMENDING CHAPTER 134, SCHEDULE XVI: LEFT TURNS PROHIBITED OF THE FLORENCE TOWNSHIP CODE

WHEREAS, the Township is responsible for ensuring the safe travel of roadways within the Township; and

WHEREAS, the Township Staff and Professionals, in consultation with engineers for the County of Burlington ("County Engineers"), have recommended prohibiting left turns for trucks at certain egresses along certain portions of West Front Street (CR 656) as well as prohibiting right turns for trucks along certain egresses of West Front Street (CR 656); and

WHEREAS, Township Council is in agreement with the recommendations of Township Staff and County Engineers that these measures shall only apply to trucks and will permit safe travel along West Front Street; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Council of the Township of Florence in the County of Burlington, State of New Jersey that Chapter 134 of the Township Code be and is hereby amended as follows:

ARTICLE I: AMENDED SECTIONS. Chapter 134, Schedule XVI, Subsection of this Code, entitled "Left Turns Prohibited" is amended as follows:

In accordance with the provisions of §134-18, no person shall make a left turn or any turn otherwise prohibited under this section, at any of the following intersections:

Name of Street Delaware Avenue Location

At the driveway located on Block 147.02, Lot 5

Hornberger Avenue

At Hornberger Avenue eastbound at the entrance to the parking area between 8th Avenue and 10th Avenue, 264 feet east of the

intersection of 10th Avenue

West Front Street (CR 656)

For B.179 L. 1.02, 1.03, 1.04, 1.05 (IPT WEST) left turns for trucks are prohibited from all points of egress

West Front Street (CR 656)

For B.156.01, L.90 (IPT EAST) right turns for trucks are prohibited from all points of egress

## ARTICLE TWO. Repealer, Severability and Effective Date.

- 1. Repealer. Ordinance 2020-08 and any and all other Ordinances inconsistent with the terms of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of any such inconsistencies.
- 2. Severability. In the event that any clause, section, paragraph or sentence of this Ordinance is deemed to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, then the Township Council hereby declares its intent that the balance of the Ordinance not affected by said invalidity shall remain in full force and effect to the extent that it allows the Township to meet the goals of the Ordinance.
- 3. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take effect upon proper passage in accordance with the law.
